# RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. All shooters will have to report to the Registration Counter to collect their ID / Bib Cards prior to the competition. Competitor cards must be retained by a shooter at all times while on the range.
2. At the completion of the match, all shooters who have participated in the SOSCC must have their coupon endorsed by the Range officer and drop it into the coupon box in order to be eligible for the lucky draw at the end of the competition.
3. Participation in team events is open to any 3 persons playing the same match number.
4. STRA shall provide arms (Indian) and ammunition to the competitors apart from its members only upon receipt of advance application and subject to availability. Rate of arms and ammunition will be notified later.
5. Shooters will be allowed to use their own arms and ammunition in the practice / competition, subject to its being as per ISSF specifications and subject to checking by competition officials.
6. Ammunition will be provided by STRA upon deposit of the Shooters weapon license / Govt. issued photo ID card in ORIGINAL.
7. Ammunition must be collected 1 hour prior to start time of the detail and empty fired shells and unfired live ammunition must be returned back to the STRA counter immediately completion of the match, without which the original arms license / Govt issued photo ID card will not be returned to the shooter.
8. Weapons sharing is allowed. However, an application for the same must be submitted along with the entry form along with a self attested copy of the arms license. The application must mention the names of the shooters sharing the weapon, weapon number, arms license number and validity period of the license. Application can be downloaded from the STRA website.
9. All responsibility for safety of weapon, ammunition and other accessories at all times will be solely of the concerned shooter. Shooters must not bring any weapon with a history of malfunctioning and in case of any accident or untoward incident, the shooter in question shall be personally liable and responsible for all financial and legal consequences for injury or death to self or any other person on the range premises and the management of the STRA or its appointees shall be held completely indemnified by the said shooter.
10. Unboxed weapon must be in break-open and unloaded condition. Weapons must be boxed at all times except while required to be used on the range for shooting or in the designated "Dry Practice Area"
11. Changing of a working weapon during the competition is not allowed. However in case of a malfunction during the competition, the gun may be replaced subject to the approval of the Range officer / Jury
12. Empty weapon mounting practice must be done only in the designated area clearly marked for this purpose.
13. Every competitor is bound to shoot / fire in the detail which is allotted to him / her by the competition administration.
14. Competitors shall have to present themselves one hour before the scheduled start of his/her event at the range. Information regarding details allotment will be posted on Facebook / Website of STRA. It is the shooters responsibility to keep him / herself updated of the same.
15. Every competitor is bound to co-operate with the competition administration.
16. If Competitor will remain absent in the competition / championship no entry fee will be refunded by the management.
17. Any incorrect information or incomplete details, in the entry form by the competitor regarding their previous score or other matters will lend the shooter liable to be debarred for two years from taking part in any competition. The shooter's club is also responsible for the recommendation on the shooters form.
18. The Shooter will have to return any unused ammunitions / empties on completion of his / her match if provided by the STRA
19. Shooters will have to agree to abide by all the instructions issued by the administration / authorized person from time to time, failing which, disciplinary action may be taken.
20. Medals will be awarded even if a single competitor has competed in a category, provided he / she has achieved the MQS of that category. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual.
21. Guns having larger than 12 bore are not allowed. Single barrel and side by side or over-under 12 bore shotguns are allowed. Pump action or automatic guns of any bore are not allowed. Semi automatic gun is allowed with only two shots loaded. Safety flags must be inserted while not firing.
22. All matches except NOVICES & Fun Shooting will be conducted on voice operated electronic system. A maximum of 12 seconds delay will be allowed between consecutive shooters. The first TIME violation will invite a warning and the subsequent / repeated such violation may lead to deduction of score.
23. Camouflage clothing & accessories, multi pocket pants, jeans, corduroy material clothing, open toe / heel footwear, and any private logo more than 60mm in diameter are prohibited. Perfume and fragrance is not allowed to be worn. Mobile phones are prohibited on the range and must be in switch off or silent mode in all other areas
24. Flash photography and smoking is prohibited at all areas on the range. Spitting is prohibited on all areas of the property
25. Shorts may be worn but the bottom of the leg must not be more than 15 cms from center of the knee cap. Sleeveless shirts/t-shirts are not allowed. The sleeve must be more than 10 cms from the shoulder drop.
26. Eye & Ear protection is urged.
27. A maximum of 6 shooters will be allotted a detail
28. There will be a minimum gap of 1 detail between two details of 50 clay matches
29. Shooters are bound to comply with all rules and bye laws of the Arms Act 1956, Arms Rules 2016, ISSF, NRAI rules.
30. Competitors must be present at the range 1 hour prior to his / her match start time.
31. All competitors must sign their score sheet after their match and before leaving the firing range.
32. Any updates shall be shared on WhatsApp / Email / Facebook / Website. It is the shooters responsibility to keep him / herself apprised of NOVEMENTS.

33. A shooter may keep his chambers loaded between Stations 1 to 5. However, both chambers must be empty and the gun must be in a break open position before the Shooter turns clockwise off Station No 5 to return to Station No 1 via Station 6.
34. Unsafe actions on part of the shooter may attract immediate DISQUALIFICATION without warning or deduction of points and no arguments in this matter will be entertained under any circumstances.
35. If a shooter is in doubt regarding the decision of the REFEREE (HIT / LOST), he / she must immediately raise the hand and bring the matter to the notice of the REFEREE / Chief of Referees. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES shall any claim be entertained regarding a disputed score at the completion of the Match. Decision of the Referee will be final
36. In case a NO Target is declared, the shooter must retake the SHOT. A HIT on a No target is not counted.
37. All winners are advised to attend the Prize Distribution ceremony. The STRA / VDRA will not be responsible for the safe handling of medals / trophies of shooters after the completion of the event.
38. Certificates shall be issued to all participants but medals shall be given only upon achieving of the Minimum Qualifying Score as mentioned against the respective match in the Match List
39. All entries (including team entries) must reach either of the below mentioned addresses in Hard Copy latest by 10/07/2019. Thereafter, triple entry will be chargeable upto 1800 hrs on 15/07/2019. No entry will be accepted thereafter unless with the express permission of the President VDRA/STRA.
40. Non verbal coaching is allowed
41. A shooter below 21 years of age as on 31/12/2019 will be considered to be Junior. All competitors entering for Junior / Veteran event must attach an attested copy of their Birth Certificate with their form without which their application is liable for rejection. Note Junior 12 – 21 years, Open 21 and above, Veteran Above 60 years. As per Arms Act, a shooter must have completed 12 years of age on the date of the competition.
42. Veg / Non Veg meals / snack and beverages will be available at separate counters on payment of applicable charges.
43. This competition is being conducted especially to encourage new shooters along with the experienced shooters. Certain relaxations have been made in number of shots, MQS in certain categories however, there will be no relaxation in matters pertaining to safety and discipline

I have studied the above rules and regulations (Nos 1 to 42) and I hereby agree to abide by these rules and regulations. I hereby also agree to abide by the rules and regulations of latest N.R.A.I. Match Book and changes by ISSF / NRAI / GSRA / VDRA / STRA.
